The deposit will be ± 100.00 per day of attendance, for example if your child will be attending 2 days per week your deposit will be $\pm 200.00 +$ the ± 50.00 registration fee. The deposit will be refunded to you when your child leaves the nursery (subject to your account being settled and that you give one months notice in writing). Leah from 'Diddi Dance' visits our Nursery for an hours session of singing and dancing. The hour is split for our three main age ranges. Babies and 2-3 year olds each participate in a 15 minute session, and children who are 3-5 years have a 30 minute session.

Diddi Dance use all of their own original music and resources. The children sing, dance, jump, gallop and shake using action songs, dancing games and fun exercises.

These sessions are full of coordination and creativity, and the children absolutely love them.
