Waingels Gardens Day Nursery Fees - May 2023

Dear parent,

We have pleasure in attaching a price list, some information and details of our admission procedures at Waingels Gardens Day Nursery.

The nursery opened in 2018 and we encourage you to visit us to meet the team. If you wish for your child to be considered for a place please complete the enrolment form, which serves merely to express your interest and requirements. There is no charge for completing this form and you will be contacted as soon as we are able to confirm a place for your child.

We will contact you to confirm the start date and we will send you a PLACE OFFER LETTER requesting a non-refundable £50.00 registration fee and the deposit.  
The deposit will be £100.00 per day of attendance, for example if your child will be attending 2 days per week your deposit will be £200.00 + the £50.00 registration fee.  
The deposit will be refunded to you when your child leaves the nursery (subject to your account being settled and that you give one months notice in writing). The registration fee of £50 is non-refundable.  
Both the registration fee and deposit are non-refundable should your child not start the nursery.

A detailed registration form and agreement will also be sent for your completion. Receipt of these, a copy of your child's birth certificate and the deposit will secure a place for your child.  
You will then be sent a standing order mandate to complete, which will need to be set up for the day that your child joins the nursery and for the 1st of each month following.

We like you to arrange several (usually 3) short pre-arranged visits for the week or two prior to your child starting at the nursery, where you can meet the staff, feel at home with us and complete our ADMISSION FORMS stating your child's current routines and requirements.

# We offer a vast range of age appropriate activities everyday

During each day children will have access to a range of exciting and challenging activities which will suit their individual needs and interests. Children will have regular opportunities to visit the local area on walks and outings. All children will have daily experiences in the outdoor environment where they can run, jump, slide, balance, use their imaginations, explore the endless opportunities with sand, water and physical equipment on offer. They will be able to practise their

skills and learn new skills to help them to become confident learners. The Nursery is a place where the children can learn, play and explore safely, can build friendships, within open ended play and planned learning experiences. There are opportunities for children to build, create and have their own ideas and share with others with the vast resources we have on offer. We believe this is an excellent foundation for the next stages in children's learning.

## Singing and Dancing

Leah from 'Diddi Dance' visits our Nursery for an hours session of singing and dancing. The hour is split for our three main age ranges.

Babies and 2-3 year olds each participate in a 15 minute session, and children who are 3-5 years have a 30 minute session. Diddi Dance use all of their own original music and resources. The children sing, dance, jump, gallop and shake using action songs, dancing games and fun exercises. These sessions are full of coordination and creativity, and the children absolutely love them.



**Qualified coach, Archie from USport visits our Nursery for an hour and a half on a Tuesday. The children love to participate in the sports sessions. They play games that focus on agility, balance and coordination. Usports coaches work in coordination with the government's EYFS scheme and encourage children to work in a team, learning skills in football, rugby, cricket and netball.**

# The early years



We work towards the Early Years Foundation Stage with all children in our setting. The EYFS helps us to build the foundations of children's learning with guidance set by the government. We ensure that we provide every child with a safe environment where they can thrive. Children can sleep according to their individual needs within their own base rooms.

# In the Kitchen

FRESH & BALANCED MEALS ARE PREPARED EVERY DAY

We cook with fresh ingredients daily in our large onsite kitchen to provide the children with Breakfast, a cooked Lunch and Pudding and Tea, as well as snacks. Fresh drinking water and milk is also readily available for children to drink during the day. Some of the snacks offered to the children include; bananas, grapes, blueberries, carrots and cucumbers. The children also participate in cooking activities where we teach them about weighing ingredients and the importance of healthy eating.
